Thanks to the generous support of our community, God blesses the Rescue Mission each year by giving us the opportunity to:

- *Provide 147,930 meals to homeless and underprivileged men, women and children.*
- *Distribute 3,840 food boxes to 6,290 individuals and families.*
- *Provide 30,677 nights of care to men and women residing at the Mission.*
- *Eleven students graduated from our new Skills for Success Job Training Program in the construction trade.*
- *Provide 13,677 shelter nights of care where 83% found permanent housing.*
- *Hold 152 chapel services with 1,444 in attendance.*
- *Witnessed 11 individuals make faith decisions for Christ.*
- *Provided academic and job skills training to 375 men and women.*

Reaching Out...Changing Lives



Founded in 1890, the Rescue Mission of Utica is a faith-based, non-profit, multiple-service, charitable organization serving Utica and the Mohawk Valley. Open 24 hours a day, 365 days a year, the ministry “endeavors to assess and meet the physical, emotional and spiritual needs of all people coming for assistance.”

The Rescue Mission provides safe lodging, food, clothing, case management, counseling, advocacy, education, referrals and support services for individuals overcoming homelessness, abuse, addictions and disabilities.



- **Addictions Crisis Center** - The Addictions Crisis Center (ACC) is a 20 bed faith based Residential Stabilization Service regulated by the New York State Office of Alcohol and Substance Abuse Services for adult men and women with Substance Use Disorder. Our clinical staff work with each person to develop an individualized treatment plan to stabilize and plan for recovery.
- **Emergency Shelter** - Drug and alcohol free shelter for men that provides safe lodging, meals, clothing, critically needed counseling, education, advocacy and referrals to agencies that meet the needs of the clientele.
- **Enriched Living Center** - New York State licensed, 52-single room residential program for adult men and women with mental illness. The program is based on the principles of Psychiatric Rehabilitation. Trained staff are available on site 24 hours each day. Many major human services are provided.
- **Parker House Aftercare Program** - “Change begins within.” For men who are committed to overcoming their drug and alcohol addiction. The 6 to 9 month program provides safe lodging, meals, clothing, critically needed counseling, education, and Godly counsel.
- **Spiritual Life Program** - Primary emphasis on training men in the principles of the Kingdom. Includes spiritual counseling, Bible studies, chapel services and more.

Those who participate in our rehabilitation services can also utilize the following programs which are also available to the community:

- **Clothing Program** - Thanks to the generosity of a caring community, we are able to provide free clothing to our residents, clients and community members.
- **Meal Program** - Free, nutritious meals are served to anyone in the community who is hungry for breakfast, lunch and dinner. In addition, food boxes are available. One food box provides 21 meals for each member of a family.
- **Morris Learning Center** - A self-paced, computer-oriented model of study that offers a safe place where men and women can work on academic and vocational skills, and set healthy life goals while working to remove barriers to employment.
- **Representative-Payee Program** - The Representative Payee Program provides bill paying and case management services to people in the community who are unable to manage their own financial affairs. Trained staff assists clients in developing a budget for payment of rent, utilities, living supplies, food and other necessities.
- **Skills for Success Job Training Program** - A construction skill building program where individuals strive to gain meaningful career opportunities and employment through a construction trades program.
