Thanks to the generous support of our community, God blesses the Rescue Mission each year by giving us the opportunity to:

- Provide 154,127 hot meals to homeless and underprivileged men, women and children.
- Distribute 3,206 food boxes to 6,290 shutins and underprivileged families, this is an additional 93.975 meals
- Provide 18,110 nights of care to 60 men and women residing at the Mission.
- Provide 71% of our Skills for Success graduates access to employment or higher education.
- Provide 17,980 shelter nights of care
- Hold over 140 chapel services with 2,040 in attendance.
- Celebrate 45 professions of faith.
- Provided academic and job skills training to 275 men and women at our Learning Center.
- Assist 700 adults with financial management in our Representative-Payee Program.
- 1,286 volunteers provided 19,671 hours of service.
- Open West Street Apartments with 42, 1-2BR units that are new, beautiful, and affordable.

Founded in 1890, the Rescue Mission of Utica is a faith-based, non-profit, multiple-service, charitable organization serving Utica and the Mohawk Valley. Open 24 hours a day, 365 days a year, the ministry "endeavors to assess and meet the physical, emotional and spiritual needs of all people coming for assistance."

The Rescue Mission provides safe lodging, food, clothing, case management, counseling, advocacy, education, referrals and support services for individuals overcoming homelessness, abuse, addictions and disabilities.



- Addiction Stabilization Center- is a 25
 bed faith based Residential Stabilization
 Service regulated by the New York State
 Office of Alcohol and Substance Abuse
 Services for adult men and women with
 Substance Use Disorder.
- Emergency Shelter is a 59 bed drug and alcohol free shelter for men that provides safe lodging, meals, clothing, critically needed counseling, education, advocacy and referrals to agencies that meet the needs of the clientele.
- Enriched Living Center New York State licensed, 52-single room residential program for adult men and women with mental illness. Trained staff are available on site 24 hours each day. Many major human services are provided.
- Parker House Aftercare Program "Change begins within." For men who are
 committed to overcoming their drug
 and alcohol addiction. The 6 to 9 month
 program provides safe lodging, meals,
 clothing, critically needed counseling,
 education, and Godly counsel.
- Spiritual Life Program Primary emphasis on training men in the principles of the Kingdom. Includes spiritual counseling, Bible studies, chapel services and more.
- West Street Apartments are located at 1013 West Street in Utica are designed to help households afford to live in Utica near employment centers, day care facilities, bus routes and more. We can provide income qualified households the opportunity to live at a reduced rent.

Those who participate in our rehabilitation services can also utilize the following programs which are also available to the community:

- Clothing Program Thanks to the generosity of a caring community, we are able to provide free clothing to our residents, clients and community members.
- Meal Program Free, nutritious meals are served to anyone in the community who is hungry for breakfast, lunch and dinner. In addition, food boxes are available.
 One food box provides 15 meals for each member of a family.
- Learning Center A self-paced, computeroriented model of study that offers a safe place where men and women can work on academic and vocational skills, and set healthy life goals while working to remove barriers to employment.
- Representative-Payee Program The
 Representative Payee Program provides
 bill paying and case management
 services to people in the community who
 are unable to manage their own financial
 affairs. Trained staff assists clients in
 developing a budget for payment of rent,
 utilities, living supplies, food and other
 necessities.
- Skills for Success Job Training Program A
 construction skill building program where
 individuals strive to gain meaningful
 career opportunities and employment
 through a construction trades program.
