TT'S UP TO US, AS GOD'S CHILDREN, TO STEP UP!

E milie is passionate about finding ways to help others. Inspired by her favorite Bible verse, she continually asks herself, "What can I do for 'the least of these'?"

During childhood, Emilie endured some of the same challenges experienced by our Mission guests. Emilie's parents were both alcoholics, and her father's violent temper ruled the household. Eventually, her parents split, poverty set in and the children were separated.

Later, Emilie's mother entered a women's shelter, and a miracle happened: she found lasting sobriety. As a result of her recovery work, Emilie's mom set out to repair relationships with her children while devoting herself to Christ's teachings through a life of service.

Her mother's humble example is what set Emilie on her journey of faith in action. "I was able to empathize with feelings of fear and shame... but I also grew to know redemption. I wanted to share that light of hope, whenever possible."

One day, Emilie's pastor approached her about a board position at the Mission. "This was my opportunity to make an impact – to give back to an organization like the one that had helped my mom!"

In her years serving on the board, Emilie has helped to steer the Mission, using her own experiences in conjunction with those of her peers. "We all have the same goal: distill our ideas down to what God wants for this place."

Emilie loves seeing the results of our programs and services reflected in the transformed lives of our guests. "I remember the struggles and triumphs of my own mom, and it makes me happy to witness each of these neighbors working to become whole again."
